With our Prime Network, members can choose from over 65,800 private and group practice health professionals, 144 hospitals, and numerous facilities in 28 New York State counties, including all five boroughs of New York City (the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, and Staten Island), plus Nassau, Suffolk, Orange, Rockland, and Westchester counties and upstate areas that stretch north of Albany.

The **ConnectiCare Choice HMO Network** has over 20,000 primary care providers and specialists, and 28 hospitals located in the 8 counties in the state of Connecticut.

The **QualCare HMO Network** has over 25,000 primary care providers and specialists, and 65 hospitals located in the 21 counties in the state of New Jersey.

Unless it's an emergency, members may have to pay for medical services if they get treatment outside of our tristate network.

### Cost-sharing:

Copays are required for the following health services:

- Services provided by a primary care provider (PCP)
- Diabetic equipment, supplies, and self-management
- Outpatient mental health and substance abuse care
- Treatment for autism spectrum disorder
- Telemedicine
- Acupuncture
- Prescription drugs
- Equipment and devices

### Pharmacy:

- Members have access to Express Scripts' National Preferred Formulary.
- Express Scripts home delivery is convenient and can save members money when filling prescriptions for some medicines.
- Express Scripts can deliver a 90-day supply of certain prescription drugs instead of the typical 30-day supply, so members will need refills less often and may be less likely to miss a dose of their medicine. This can lead to better health outcomes.
