**Important Note:** Updated information related to HIV testing in New York State is being developed in conjunction with Chapter 308 of the Laws of 2010 (an HIV testing law effective September 1, 2010). This law makes changes to who must be offered testing, the consent process, and the rules for disclosure of HIV-related information.
